We are almost ending our second term this week. As you may know, we finish our academic year in December. Therefore, our students are going to have two weeks of vacation because our national celebrations. This term has been busiest than before because school anniversary activities (we celebrated our 102th anniversary!!) and two short trips. I was able to travel twice to USA in order to make some contacts with churches and people and let them know about our school. We are still looking for teachers in order to support our bilingual program. However my second trip was more related to start our relationship with Dallas Baptist University and our school. I spent two weeks in Texas with 39 students. That was an exhausting experience but I think it was very rewarding for the students as well.



I obtained the permission of the board to buy a small property not very far from the school in order to expand our Elementary (Kindergarten) level. This is going to be a big economical investment but we think this is what our school needs in order to be more attractive to prospective students.
